Dear Parents,

Thank you all for your patience and understanding regarding the speed of communication from school to home. Our Directors asked that all Principal's meet on line at 1:30 pm this afternoon and following this meeting letters would be sent.

As you know, Wednesday the ETSB asked each school to distribute a letter highlighting information regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the virus that is making headlines in the news daily. Thursday we sent home a document about the correct method to wash your hands. As well, there was an instruction document on the best way to prevent germs from spreading when you cough or sneeze. I recommend that you post these documents in a key area in the house. Later this afternoon the ETSB will be sending home a letter confirming that the school will be closed for two weeks to help to decrease the spreading of the virus. Starting Monday, March 16 there will be no school. It is anticipated that we will return to school on Monday, March 30, 2020. Please keep a close watch on the ETSB website and your email account. Letters will be distributed when any new developments are shared with us as the weeks unfold.
